**Decision and time:
Reconsidering the past, anticipating the future**

30th June – 3rd July 2009

The topic of the Summer School is the relationship between decision and time, an interdisciplinary object of study for psychology, economics, and other social sciences.

The aim is to provide participants with the opportunity to attend high-level lectures followed by discussions, to present their own research projects in order to have constructive feedback and to work actively in small groups on specific topics provided by the lecturers. The general goal is to foster the circulation of new ideas and methodologies and to promote the establishment of contacts among participants.

The Summer School will be structured as follows:

Main lectures which deal with a specific issue related to the general theme;

Working groups where participants will work in small groups on a research topic provided by each lecturer;

Workshops where participants will present their research projects;

Research focuses with presentations of pieces of research to stimulate discussion and critical reflection.

A website and a platform will support the activities of the Summer School.

The attendance includes admission to all the sessions (lectures, discussions, working groups, research focuses), presentation of one's own research project, access to the platform and to the uploaded materials and forum, submission of a paper for possible inclusion in the book, social dinner. Attendance fees are 480.00 euros (VAT included). There will be the possibility of some financial supports.
